Note:

After all of the requested documentation is received the applicant's documentation will be reviewed by the American Chiropractic Physician Credentialing Center Credentials Committee. This process could take up to 90-120 days. Upon completion of ACPCC credentialing, and successful credentials verification through Med-Advantage, each applicant will be given the opportunity to sit for the ACPCC Examination, a 300 multiple choice Advanced Clinical Examination (ACE), an advanced practice clinical skills examination. The rubric for this examination is found on www.acpcc.org

Successful completion/passing of credentialing, credentials verification and the ACE examination will qualify the applicant for the use of the designation APCM-C®, and use of Advanced Practice Chiropractor® and Advanced Practice Chiropractic Physician®.
