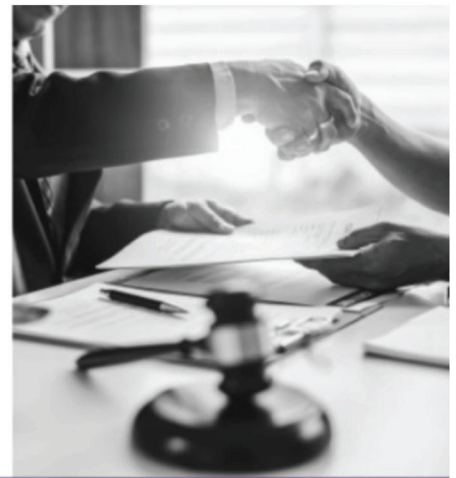

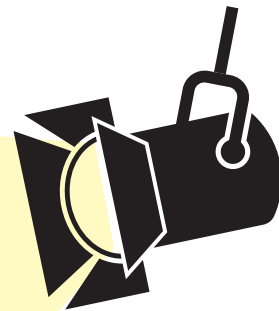

## Lifetime Achievement Award Recipient *Dr. Lyman Atchley's story...*

It was a great honor to receive the Life Time Achievement Award in 2019. Here is a little history of my years in the chiropractic profession and the NMCA.

I graduated from Palmer College of Chiropractic in 1965. After graduation, I practiced as an associate at Blair Chiropractic Clinic in Lubbock, Texas. I moved back to Albuquerque to begin my practice in 1967 and I continue to practice today with my son, Dr. Derek Atchley.

I have always believed that to make a difference in life, you must be involved. I began my involvement by joining the NMCA in 1967. I served as a member or chair of various committees. I was elected president of the NMCA from 1971 -1974 and continue to be an active member.

I was also appointed to the New Mexico Board of Chiropractic Examiners under two different governors. I was elected chairman by the board members each time. As such, I was a member of the National Federation of Chiropractic Examiners. I was also honored to be named Chiropractor of the Year in 2014.

As Dr. Herbert Beatty stated so elegantly in his story, "Our lives stand on the shoulders of those that have gone before us, encouraged us, taught us, and were examples for us." There are many individuals I can list. However, the ones that had the most im-



pact on my professional life were Dr. Darrel Atchley, Dr. Bill Blair, Dr. John Simons, Dr. James Martz, and Dr. James Parker.

Now as Paul Harvey used to say, "Here is the rest of the story." I am a second generation native New Mexican, born and raised on a ranch, in the north-eastern part of New Mexican. Both my grandparents were homesteaders in the Oklahoma Land Rush. Little did I ever dream of becoming a chiropractor, although our family doctor was a chiropractor in Clayton New, Mexico.

It wasn't until 1961 that my direction in life changed. After being adjusted (ASL to be specific) by my cousin, Dr. Darrel Atchley, I decided that this was

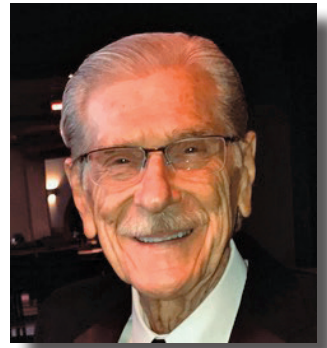

# Letter to the Editor

Dear fellow colleagues,

I have been contemplating the challenge of thinking 'outside the box'. Many of you have tried to solve the puzzle of connecting the nine dots with only four straight lines. Here is that puzzle:



The solution is quite simple, however when I was first challenged with this puzzle I could only think 'inside' the box. There are parallels to this puzzle in my chiropractic career. I graduated from the Palmer College 53 years ago and had a very 'inside' the box view of what it meant to be a Doctor of Chiropractic. While BJ Palmer was emphatic about the role of the subluxated spine in health, he was also a seeker in his philosophical journey. In fact, he said this:

"To take in a new idea, you must destroy the old, let go of old opinions, to observe and conceive of a new thought. To learn is but to change your opinion."

I remember attending Reggie Gold late night student lectures while at Palmer Homecoming in 1966 and 67. Reggie was certainly passionate about the subluxation, all the while chain smoking through the evening. At the time I thought that surely there was an important contribution to health made with an adjustment, however one's lifestyle also had much to do with the health of the individual and that chain smoking, while advocating for the adjustment, seemed at odds with his chiropractic philosophy. Over my lifetime I have become a more 'ecumenical' thinker along the lines of what constitutes a good healthcare equation

For example, many patients with significant bruising and dermal hematomas are caused by blood thinners and aging skin. Is this a subluxation issue? Not in my current thinking. Good research shows that many people are deficient in the Vitamin C Complex and especially

the bioflavonoids such as rutin, hesperidin, quercetin and iso-quercetin. We now know that about 80% of the positive Covid 19 population is deficient in Vitamin D. (Journal of Clinical Endocrinology & Metabolism). Dermatologists have demonized sun exposure recommending sunscreen products and avoidance. Is this a subluxation caused circumstance? There are many other examples I might point out in the challenges that we as Doctor of Chiropractic encounter every day that require us to think 'outside of the box' of the philosophical subluxation.

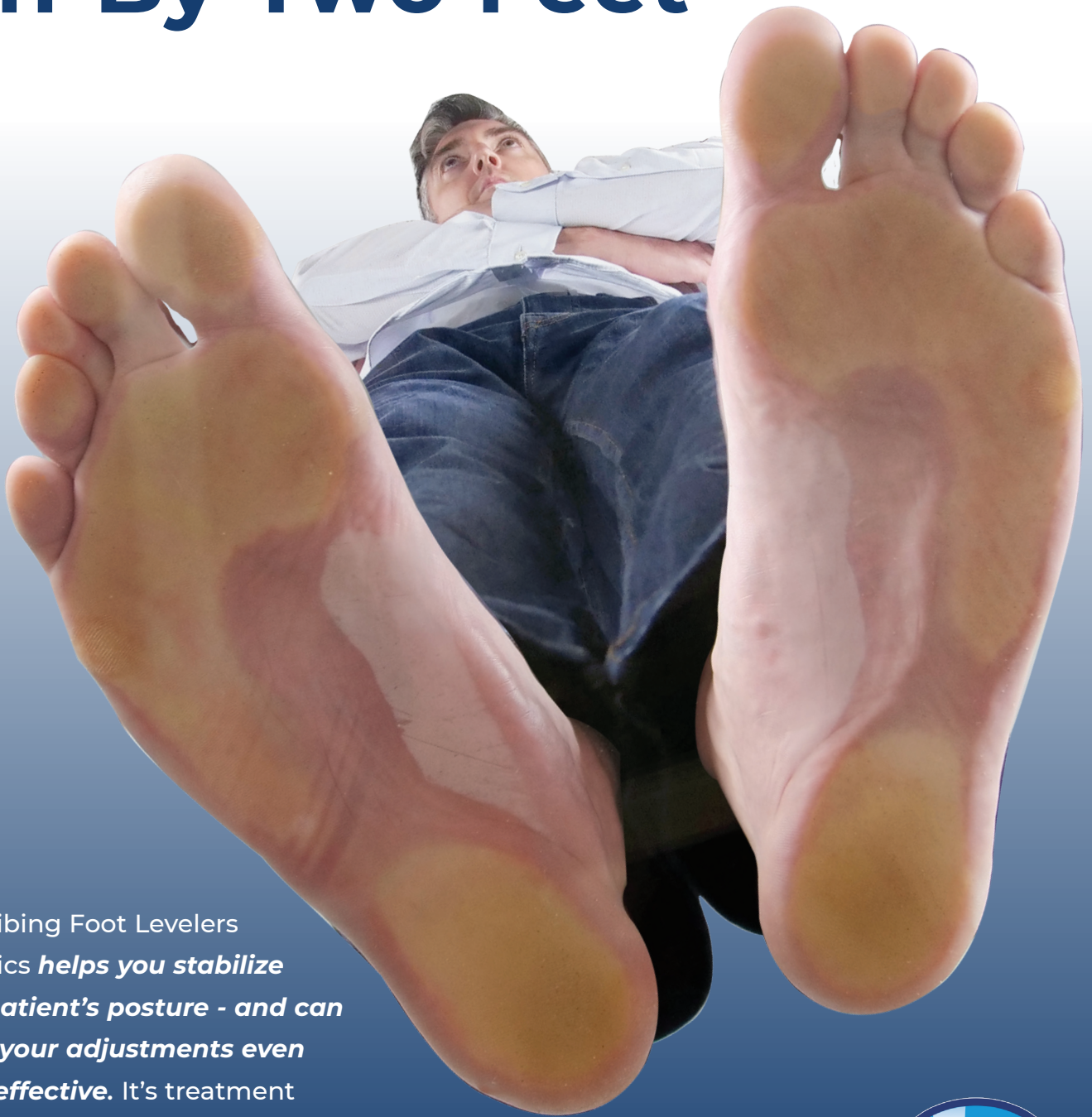

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# VP FALL 2021 Report

Over the past few months, myself and other NMCA leaders have enjoyed multiple opportunities to meet with and present to policy makers on issues facing chiropractic physicians and their patients in New Mexico. The most encouraging aspect of these interactions is that lawmakers and state leaders solicited us for our involvement in these meetings. It is very apparent when state leaders want to hear from the chiropractic profession they come to the NMCA for input. This is a testament to the quality of our associations members and it's leadership for the past 74 years.

Over the summer, Dr. Michael Pridham and myself had the opportunity to meet with the Human Ser-

vices Deputy Secretary and others to discuss reimbursement for chiropractic physicians in the New Mexico Medicaid program. Although there are still significant obstacles to state wide coverage for chiropractic physicians, significant gains were made. We have been asked to participate in a Medicaid workgroup for chiropractic medicine inclusion. The work group will include representatives from the NMCA, HSD, the NM Medical Assistance Division, and Health Insurance Industry. The purpose of the group is to develop and implement a pilot program to study costs and patient outcomes in the Medicaid population. Prior research in this area has shown excellent results, and I'm optimistic we'll see the same conclusions locally.

In September, the NMCA was asked to present at the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee. I participated in a group panel with other complementary medicine providers on the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic on our practices and barriers to access in patient care. It was an excellent opportunity to educate our lawmakers on our value to the healthcare system and common issues that patients have seeing a chiropractic physician. The message was well received and a common theme among all presenting provider groups.

Just last month, NMCA leaders were asked by the Office of the Superintendent Insurance to participate with other providers discussing the Health Security Act. The New Mexico legislature has asked the Office of Superintendent of Insurance (OSI) to research key policy questions about the Health Security Act. After discussing priorities with bill sponsors and advocates, OSI has identified several issue areas, one of which is how providers would be paid under the plan. OSI has contracted with researchers at Columbia University and Rutgers to explore the topic and would like to give the researchers the opportunity to discuss the opportunities and challenges that providers foresee with this initiative. The Health Security Act would provide universal health care coverage to all New Mexicans.

I am grateful and humbled for every opportunity the NMCA provides to promote the chiropractic profession in the evolving healthcare landscape. The NMCA will continue to advocate for you and your patients.



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# ACA FALL 2021 Report

The American Chiropractic Association is happy to report that we have broken the triple digit mark and now have 100 cosponsors for HR2654 the Chiropractic Medicare Coverage Modernization Act!

This is a historic milestone in our profession and has been a great boost of moral within the House of Delegates. It comes on the heels of the New Mexico Overdose Prevention and Pain Management Advisory Council passing my recommendation to vote on a statement supporting the legislation. There were two field representatives for Senator Ben Ray Lujan and Representative Teresa Leger Fernandez at the meeting and I followed up with communications to ask for their support.

At the time of the writing of this article we do not have any New Mexico Representatives who have cosponsored, so please continue to call, email, and encourage your Congresswoman to sign onto HR2654!

I was interviewed by researchers at the Duke University Margolis Center for Health Policy about my work with the UNM Pain Department and the case report was published in October. Doctors Lucy Whyte-Ferguson and Tom Arnold have both worked at the Pain Center for several years. Our Pain Department has been recognized as being one of the top four departments in the country largely due to the integrative approach and for offering chiropractic medicine. The case study highlighted

the fact that the leadership has goals of improving reimbursement for integrative services.

After a decade or more of advocating for Tricare to add chiropractic medicine benefits, we are part of the proposal to begin coverage in 2022. There are still some steps that have to be taken to finalize the proposal, however this is another important step that the ACA has been continuing to work on to improve the lives of our veterans.

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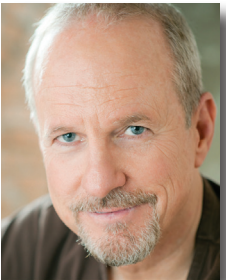

## ICA Here for You Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow Guarding the Sacred Trust

Since 1926, when the Developer of Chiropractic, Dr. B.J. Palmer established the Chiropractic Health Bureau, we have been standing up for you and with you as chiropractors. In 1940, our name was changed to the International Chiropractors Association. We continue today what B.J. started – protecting and promoting chiropractic.

**In Fall 2021** we find ourselves in situations that are not aligned with the inalienable human rights of health freedom, freedom of movement, freedom of speech. In a world of public health that promotes evidence-based decision making, we see credible science such as the value of natural immunity being ignored to be replaced with a totalitarian approach of compulsory vaccination as a tool to force compliance. Having this forced upon all health care workers in some locations, for all government employees at federal and state/provincial levels, and as condition of employment and even an ability to have a business open. We see the institution of a ‘show me your papers’ system in which private medical data is required to be disclosed in order to travel, to dine in restaurants, attend a concert, and to attend sporting events.

This after enduring 18 months of shutdowns, lockdowns, flattening the curve, masking, limitations of speech on social media; and a cancel culture environment that is reminiscent of countries and times in history in which freedom was/is nonexistent. As we have always done, the International Chiropractors Association is and continues to take a leadership role for the chiropractic community during times of crisis. When the pandemic was declared, we stood up a resource page and were the first in the US to issue a comprehensive report detailing what was in the peer reviewed literature regarding the effect of the chiropractic adjustment on the immune system. Our report concluded with a call for research and specifically high-quality evaluations in real world environments of the whole person effect of regular chiropractic care so that we can measure not just the immune response, but also the response of all body systems using measures that are accepted in health research inside and outside of chiropractic. Remember, at the beginning, the ‘experts’ told us that the healthier the individual, the better their outcomes if exposed to the virus. The **health of the host is the key** to this and any exposure. You will be hearing a lot of about this in the coming weeks from ICA and ICA leaders.

In August our Board issued a new policy statement (available at: <https://www.chiropractic.org/advocacy/health-freedom/>) in which we unequivocally stand up for you and your freedom. The statement includes the following:

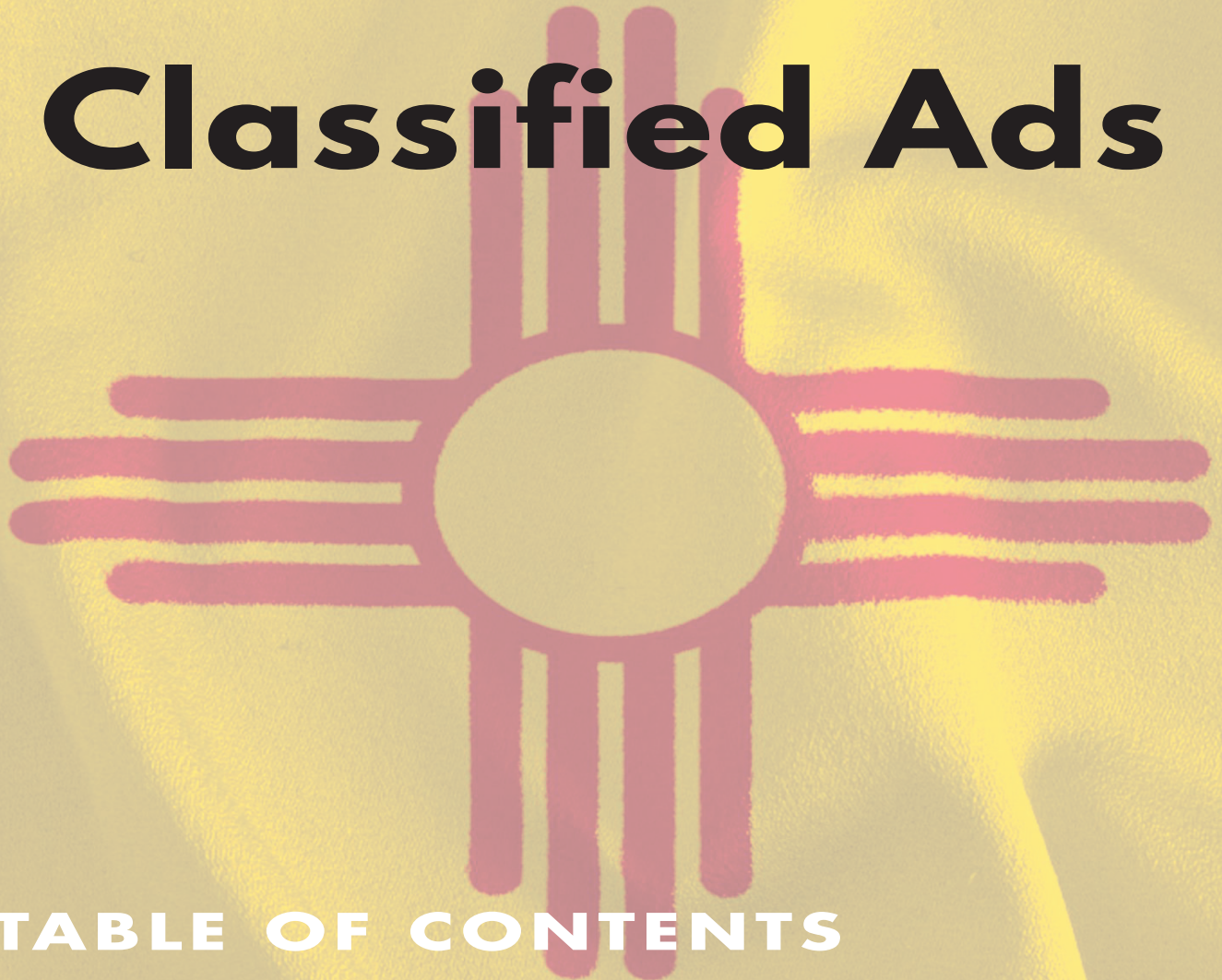

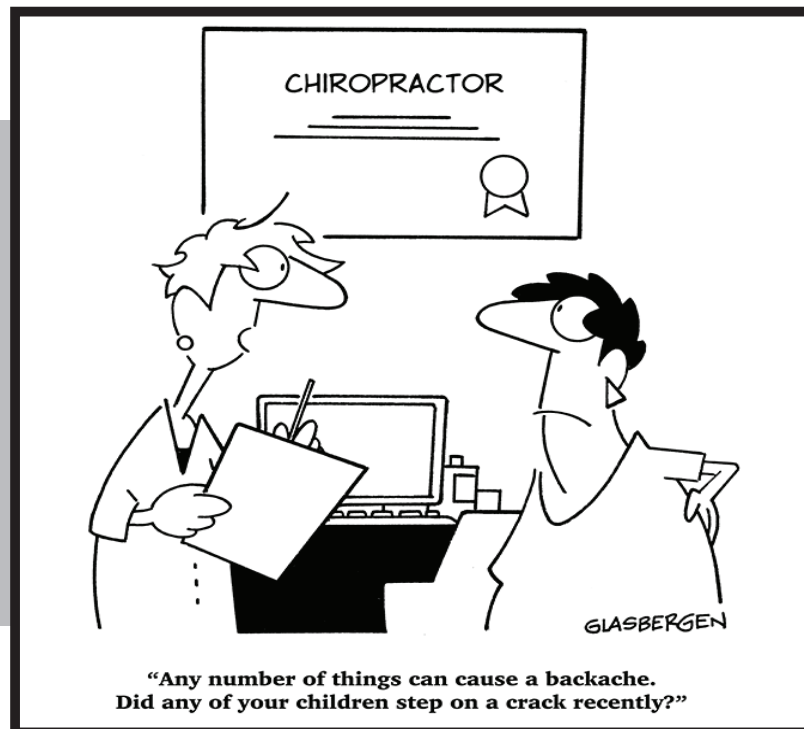
