Let’s keep that spirit alive by continuing to give, to serve, and most importantly, to listen.

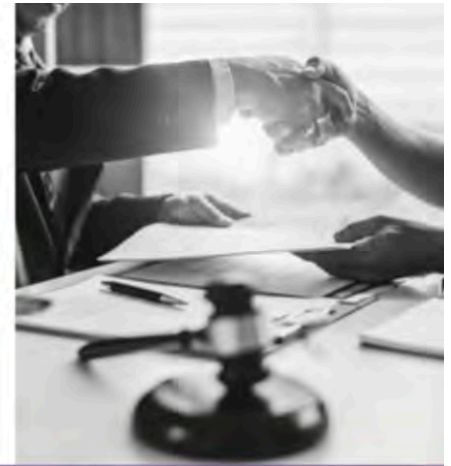

Vice President's Report

Fall is such a beautiful time in New Mexico! I just returned from hiking Mount Kilimanjaro and it was an experience of a lifetime! The summit sits at 19,341 feet and the seven-day hike was the most challenging and rewarding journey of my life. Thank you for all of you who encouraged me along the way!

Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham signed a proclamation that I requested her to release saying that October is Chiropractic Health Month. These proclamations are available for each of you to print out and frame in your clinic.

I have attended town hall meetings for State Representative Marianna Anaya and State Senator Heather Bergmans. The first one was centered around Malpractice Reform. It was a packed house with about 100 people in attendance. The news cameras were there and tensions were palpable. Many providers are seeing record high malpractice rates that are driving many physicians to leave the state. Representative Anaya will likely introduce a Joint Memorial to study the issue and come up with recommendations on how to best address the situation.

At Senator Bergmans' town hall meeting, I asked about the primary care provider shortage and whether or not she would be supportive of advanced practice chiropractic physicians being able to help fill the void. She was very receptive to the discussion and we spent a lot of time discussing the subject. I told her that I have been recommending each member of the NMCA to attend their senator and representative's town hall meetings, and asked if I could share this picture of us with you

all. She was happy to take a picture for this journal, and she explained that it is very helpful for each of you to reach out to your elected officials as well.

Reflections

Dear Fellow Travelers on the Chiropractic journey,

I am a member of the Chiropractic History Association and have been for decades. This association prints an exceptionally fine Journal, at least twice a year, and provides insight into the history of our profession. My library also contains many volumes of the Green Books published by BJ and other historical publications including original issues by chiropractors writing about their perspectives and promoting individual techniques. No chiropractor achieves his or her doctoral degree independent of our history. Our history is colorful, incredibly interesting, and even at times a bit hilarious. There have been some genuinely interesting personalities along our historical journey.

An example is a book titled “The Truscott System” by Granville Kimball Frisbie DC PHC, who recounts the first class taught by Dr Leon Louis Truscott in California in 1939. Dr Truscott was concerned about the electromagnetic fields that would affect the determination of the subluxation, and his system went to great lengths to neutralize electromagnetic energy. For instance, the patient could have no metal on them. Women were in cotton gowns and men should only be in their shorts and socks. The table must be on rubber-insulated pads and there must be no synthetic materials in contact such as rayon, nylon, or even silk. Rubber bands were to be placed around each forearm and ankles as an extra precaution. The head of the table is to be oriented toward the West to neutralize any North or South magnetic disturbance at the time of the patient treatment. Of course, the attending doctor must be subluxation free or there will be no accuracy to the procedure. The analysis was primarily to determine the laterality of the Atlas coinciding with a short leg deficiency on the side of the lateral Atlas. The adjustment was a “toggle recoil”

removing the “block” to the expression of “innate forces” and thus the restoration of the innate healing ability of the body.

Recently I found a website that has compiled an ongoing list of all the chiropractic techniques developed over the years. For those interested in seeing the list you may access it at:

Contents-upc-p4-Techniques

I counted almost 120 different techniques listed in the list from A-Z. Activator Technique to Zindler Reflex Technique. This writer feels sure that the list is not complete historically.

The question obviously arises, which of these techniques have stood the test of time, and by the way, in the 21st Century have we arrived at any consensus as a profession regarding standards which we can agree upon as to what exactly are the science based chiropractic techniques that can be easily validated and understood not only by other professionals much less the general public?

Finally, the question arises, as to the debate over our philosophically based history in actual practice and the demands of the health care science community for evidence-based validation of our profession, techniques, and their rationale.

This is the crossroads that we collectively find ourselves as we journey into the 21st century and the developing world of knowledge accruing from the pressures on us all, living into the realities of Artificial Intelligence.
