President's Report



Don't Forget What You Got Here

One of the more common conversations I have with patients goes something like this.

A patient returns after several months with a familiar complaint. They had been doing well, sometimes for quite a while, but gradually the pain returned. As we talk through what changed, the answer is usually less mysterious than they expected. They stopped doing their exercises. They quit walking. Life became busy. Or perhaps they simply started feeling so good that they assumed they no longer needed the habits that had helped them recover.

I usually smile and tell them, "When you start feeling good, don't forget what got you feeling good."

The longer I've practiced, the more I've realized that advice has very little to do with back pain.

Lately, I've caught myself thinking about it in other areas of my own life. Strong relationships don't stay strong simply because they've been strong before. Like many of us, my wife and I juggle demanding careers, our children's activities, and the countless responsibilities that come with everyday life. Nothing is necessarily wrong, but if we're not intentional, it's easy for conversations to become about schedules instead of dreams, obligations instead of connection. The same habits that built a relationship are the ones that continue to sustain it, yet those are often the first things we let slip when life feels comfortable.

I've noticed a similar tendency in business. Whenever the front end of the practice slows down, it's tempting to blame the economy, changes in healthcare, or factors outside our control. Sometimes those explanations are valid. But before I settle there, I've learned it's worth asking a more uncomfortable question: Have I stopped doing the things that built this practice in the first place? Are we still investing in relationships? Are we investing in the team? Are we still learning? Are we still looking for ways to improve the patient experience?

Am I still challenging myself to grow, or have I begun relying on yesterday's success to carry tomorrow's results?

The Stoics understood this tendency well. Marcus Aurelius filled his private journal with reminders that often sound repetitive. He wasn't searching for new wisdom; he was reminding himself not to drift from the principles he already knew to be true. He understood that the greatest threat to character wasn't ignorance. It was the slow, almost imperceptible drift that comes when success convinces us the work is finished.

Perhaps that's why these reflections have stayed with me. They seem to surface in every part of life. Health isn't maintained because we once made good choices. Relationships don't flourish because we once invested in them.

Practices don't continue to grow because they were successful last year. None of the things we value most are sustained by momentum alone. They require intention, discipline, and the humility to keep doing the ordinary things long after they've stopped feeling extraordinary.

As I think about our profession, I wonder if the same principle applies.

The respect chiropractic medicine enjoys in New Mexico, the relationships we've built with legislators and other healthcare professionals, and the progress we've made over the years didn't happen because one generation had a great idea. They happened because countless doctors kept showing up. They served on boards, mentored young physicians, advocated for patients, built trust in their communities, and invested in a future they might never personally benefit from. They understood that a profession is never finished; it is always being shaped.

One of my favorite observations from Marcus Aurelius is that what is not good for the hive cannot be good for the bee. It is a reminder that our individual success can never be separated from the health of the profession we share.

Every one of us benefits from the work of those who came before us, and whether we realize it or not, someone else's future will be shaped by the work we choose to do today.

That realization has changed the questions I ask myself. Instead of wondering whether the profession is headed in the right direction, I find myself asking what role I should play in helping shape that direction. Instead of assuming the momentum will continue on its own, I wonder what habits, relationships, and commitments must be renewed if we expect progress to continue.

Perhaps that's the deeper meaning behind the advice I give my patients.

"When you are doing good, don't forget what got you doing good."

Maybe it was never just about back pain. Maybe it's about marriage. Maybe it's about raising a family. Maybe it's about leading a practice. And maybe it's about preserving and advancing a profession that has given all of us so much.

The work of building a profession is never truly finished. That is what makes it meaningful.

May we never become so comfortable with what we've accomplished that we lose sight of what remains possible.

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Vice President's Report

Like many of you, I had the privilege of knowing Dr. Kenzo Kase. Dr. Kase changed the world not simply by inventing a therapeutic tape, but by daring to bridge philosophies that had long stood apart. With Kinesio Taping, he wove together Eastern and Western perspectives—uniting biomechanics with energetic principles, structure with function, and research with intuition. His work reminds us that innovation often comes from refusing to choose one side of a divide and instead building a bridge strong enough for both.

This year, I have the privilege of carrying that spirit forward as I travel to the Kinesio Research Conference in Istanbul, Türkiye to present a case study. It's an opportunity to contribute to a global conversation that Dr. Kase began decades ago: a conversation about how healing expands when we allow disciplines to collaborate rather than compete.

Here in New Mexico, chiropractic physicians are uniquely positioned to embody that same integrative mindset. We practice at the crossroads of allopathic and holistic care. We understand the value of evidence-based

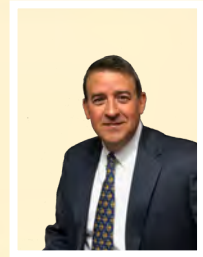

As we move forward as a profession, I believe our greatest strength lies in our ability to unify. To collaborate with medical colleagues. To bring conservative care into primary care conversations. To demonstrate, through our outcomes and our professionalism, that chiropractic is not an alternative to modern healthcare is an essential component of it.

Dr. Kase showed us what can happen when one person decides to connect disciplines instead of dividing them. My hope is that we, as chiropractic physicians in New Mexico, continue that legacy. Let's be the bridge. Let's be the profession that integrates, elevates, and leads.

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FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Here is a thought for the reader. None of us in our profession has arrived in our current practice independent of so many that have gone before. One might say we stand on the shoulders of those who dedicated their time, energy and resources establishing our right to practice today. I am not advocating for worshipping at the feet of our chiropractic ancestry; however, I do think that we should be mindful of those that paved the way for our current ability to pursue our mission as a Doctor of Chiropractic.

Those of us that practice in the Land of Enchantment have the privilege of doing so because over 105 years ago, in 1921, the New Mexico state legislature passed the Chiropractic Practice Act. It is interesting to note that dentistry was licensed in 1918, chiropractic in 1921, medicine in 1923, osteopathy in 1935 and podiatry not until 1952.

Another noteworthy fact is the New Mexico Chiropractic Association was formed by a key group of dedicated chiropractors 80 years ago. That is eight decades of continuous service to the profession in our state.

Also noteworthy is the early American Chiropractic Association (formed 1922), merged with the Universal Chiropractic Association in 1930, and formed the National Chiropractic Association, which later, in 1963, became the American Chiropractic Association as we know it today.

I was licensed in November 1968 and started my practice that same month. My license number is 354 and there were 16 chiropractors in Albuquerque at that time. I became a member of the NMCA in 1969 and have been a member now for 57 years. Over the years I became a lifetime member of the Chiropractic History Association because I was interested in and wanted to know just who went before me, what their story was, and how this knowledge would enhance my understanding of how my own opportunity to become a chiropractor was made possible. After all, had there been no trailblazers before me, how could I blaze my own trail of self-actualization.



I heard a speaker a few years ago say that he thought a human being was "a possibility of possibilities." Now this is a rather peculiar way of using the language, however that is one way of describing what is known to be the "art of the possible." My life has been made possible to attempt the possible.

Had there not been chiropractors that paved the way actualizing the possibilities of chiropractic as a healing art, then it follows that my life would not have had the possibility to become a Doctor of Chiropractic.

As we enter into this 80th anniversary year of the New Mexico Chiropractic Association, the leadership is not only looking forward but also historically back. Over the next anniversary year there will be aspects of the profession's history in New Mexico that will inform, educate and entertain each member of the profession that takes a bit of time to reflect on our heritage.

A teaser will be about the chiropractor that was responsible for the passage of the New Mexico licensing act in 1921. In a sense we owe so much to this pioneer that moved to Raton New Mexico from Missouri in 1914. New Mexico became a state in 1912. Little did he know that his efforts created the opportunity for all of us today, indeed making our lives the "art of the possible" in chiropractic in New Mexico 1114 years later.

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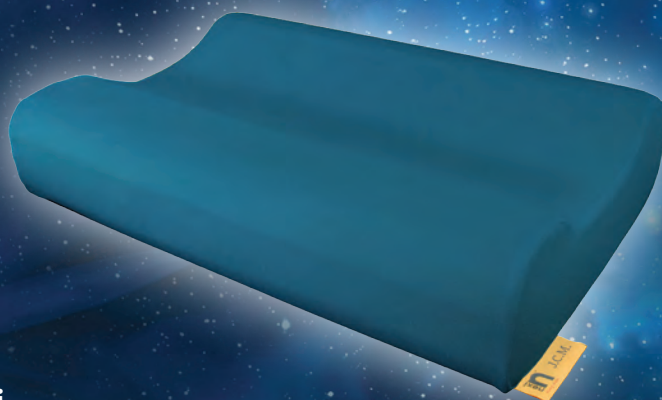

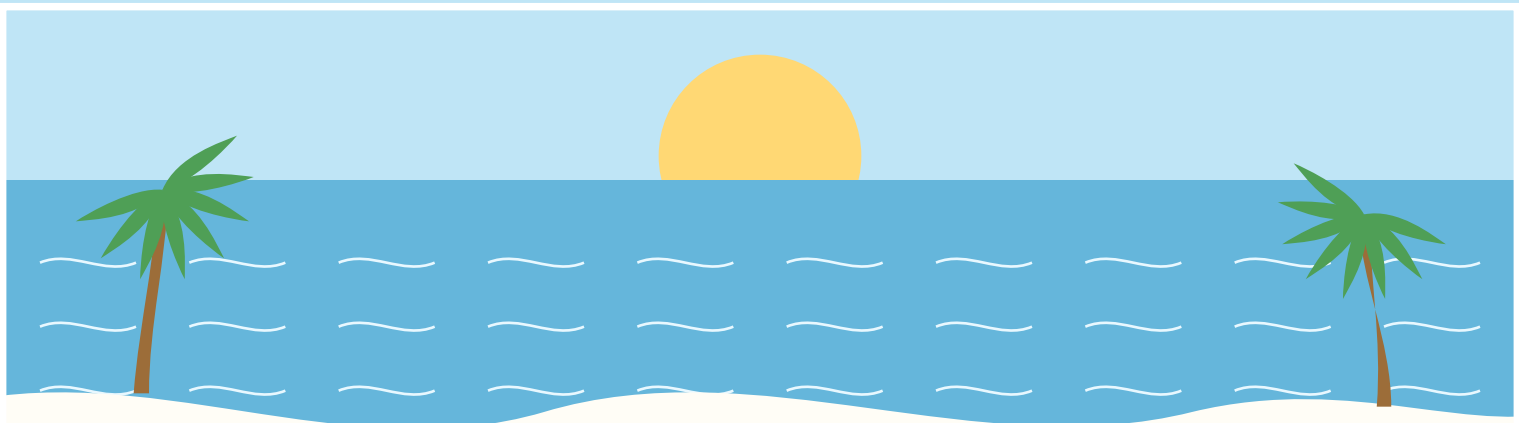
